GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING MINUTES
August 12, 2010

CALL TO ORDER: President Sandra Hoggan called the meeting to order at 6:07 P.M. in the cafeteria in conjunction with the MES Open House.

3. The transfer to a PTO as opposed to a PTA allows the monies to remain in the school as opposed to only receiving a portion of the monies collected.

5. Encouraged parents to visit the moanalupto.org website often to get information.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: L. Kamikawa

Minutes from the 5/13/2010 General Membership meeting were circulated. The minutes were unanimously approved.

TREASURER'S REPORT: R. Taone

The budget for this year is \$130,373.00. Last year our budget was \$84,000 and we spent \$82,000. It was encouraged to help the PTO raise the necessary funds in order to fund everything on this year's budget.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

- Fundraisers: VIP USA coupon book introduced as the first fundraiser of the year. It will sell for \$25, of which the school could possibly make up to \$18.75 per book in profit. The packets with further information will be distributed in August or September.
- Recruiting: Vice President Lei Fukumura encouraged parents and families to come and get involved with the PTO. She invited parents to the monthly meetings so they could give input and share ideas they may have. Manny Salvador informed the attendees that being involved with the PTO was a good way to get involved in their child's education.
